

Ringway Primary School Pupil Premium Funding Report 2015/16

The pupil premium grant was introduced in 2011 and is funding received into school annually for children entitled to free school meals, looked after children and children with parents in the armed forces.

The PPG is additional to main school funding and is used by the school in variety of ways to impact on pupil attainment and progress helping to remove any barriers to learning. The following report provides a summary of how PPG has been allocated in 2015/16.
