

Welcome to Nursery

We are looking forward to getting to know you and your children over the next few weeks. It is an exciting time for us all. If you have any questions or queries then please call the school office, leave your number and we will call you back.



From the 14th September children will start their place full time. Due to current circumstances, please have your child in school for 9.00am when the Nursery door opens. School attendance is a minimum of 96%. Pick up is at 3.00pm. To avoid overcrowding please stick to these times.

Some children may be entitled to a free school dinner. Please enquire at the office if you are eligible and complete the paperwork. School dinners can be chosen from home if you ask the office for login details. If you prefer to send a packed lunch for your child then please inform the Nursery team. Let us know about any allergies/dietary requirements. We are a no nut school and do have serious nut allergies in EYFS.



Reading is a big part of life at Ringway. We will not be sending books home due to current circumstances but after half-term will be sending bug club logins for you and your child to read interactive books together at home. We will also be sending Youtube links to stories via classdojo for you to share. Please spend 5-10 minutes reading these books together each day.

Our topic for this half term is “Marvellous Me”. We will be talking about ourselves, the people who live in our house and our extended family. Please talk to your children about what family means to you and your important family members. We will also be learning different nursery rhymes.



Finally, school uniform is compulsory. (If your child struggles with trouser clasps/tights feel free to send them in jogging bottoms/ leggings.) With the unpredictable weather make sure your child has sturdy footwear and brings a coat in every day. We love to play outside in all weathers and learn about the seasons, so if you would like to send a pair of wellies to be kept at school that would be great. **Please name** all your child’s coats and jumpers/ cardigans/wellies to avoid these being lost.
